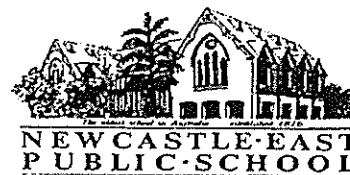


Primary Sport Program Term 1 2019



Primary students will be given three sports options to choose from in Term 1.

As numbers are strictly limited, students who did not get their first choice in Term 4 will have first choice this time. Students in Years 5 and 6 will be accommodated first. Each sport will run for 8 consecutive weeks, starting Week 3, Friday February 15th through to Week 10, Friday 5th April 2019.

The cost for each sport is as follows:

1. 8 x surfing lessons @ \$11.00 per week. Surfing includes bus travel to and from Nobbys Beach each week and a 45 minute surfing lesson with professional coaches for each of the 8 sessions. Total cost- \$88.00
2. 8 x skating lessons @ \$12.50 per week. Skating includes bus travel to and from Sanbah Grindhouse each week and a 45 minute skating lesson each week for 8 weeks. Equipment hire is also included in this cost. Total cost- \$100
Please note: Lessons are skateboarding only, no scooters.
3. Sport at Newcastle Beach/King Edward Park. For any students not signed up for the above sports. These students will play a number of ball games and beach sports on a rotation. No cost.

There are 30 places for surfing and 20 places for skating. Students who are successful in gaining a spot in a sport will receive permission notes after the due date for this expression of interest.
