Why it's Important for your Kids to Sleep Early

People do not function well without sleep. We feel

miserable, cranky and even a bit emotional. Children need their sleep too. An overtired toddler is like a spitting volcano; it is best to try and avoid it.

Everyone's ability to function normally gets compromised when we do not get sufficient sleep. Sleep is essential to everyone's well-being. It is crucial that parents ensure that children go to sleep early for many reasons

Sleep has an enormous impact on how children learn, behave, interact and their overall health. A child that does not get enough sleep won't be able to concentrate when they have to learn. There could also be behavioural problems, because a tired child is also a cranky one. It is of the utmost importance that children get enough sleep to improve concentration, deal with conflicts and interact in positive ways with their peers.

Lack of sleep puts your child at higher risk of illness. According to Kidshealth, sleep helps your brain to rest and store information. Your cells repair when you sleep and that is when most of the growing in children takes place. If they do not rest enough, their growth could be compromised.

Every child is unique and has different needs. Sleeping is important for everyone, but how sleep is spread depends from child to child. The amount of sleep a child needs, decreases as they get older. Here is a guideline of how much sleep children needs and it includes daytime naps.

• 3 – 5 years need 10 – 13 hours a day • 6 – 12 years need 9 – 12 hours a day • 13 – 18 years need 8 – 10 hours per day




Annual School Council Survey







Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. The budget also includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Newcastle East Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Newcastle East Public School to create an innovative learning environment. The project will deliver:

- four new adaptable and innovative learning spaces
- a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA)/ communal gathering space
- refurbishment of the staff administration area
- replacement of the roof of the existing heritage building.

Progress summary

Planning approval has been received and the contract for construction awarded to Artel Constructions. Construction will start in late 2018.

Site establishment starts late November

Site establishment prepares the work area for construction. Artel Constructions will:

- install fencing and hoardings to separate the site from the school grounds
- remove trees within the construction site
- remediate known asbestos within the site in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and quidelines.

Following site establishment, construction will begin with bulk excavation, removal of the existing COLA, relocation of existing services, formwork and concrete pours.

Work will take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Some work may be required outside of these approved hours to safely remediate contaminated materials. The community will be informed of any changes to the approved working hours.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Remediation of contaminated materials

The health, safety and well-being of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority. There is known asbestos within the site that will need to be remediated as part of the site establishment and early works.

Asbestos remediation will be managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

A remediation plan will be developed that will inform how these works will be carried out. Further information will be provided to the school and local community once timings have been confirmed.

Please be aware that the remediation of asbestos will pose no risk to staff, students or the local community.

Keeping you updated

Regular updates about what to expect will be provided to the school and local community throughout construction. An information booth has been scheduled for 8:30am-9:30am, Monday 5 November 2018 at Newcastle East Public School.




